Please call ahead to ensure someone will be available to receive your donation. Also, please make sure you've completed and attached a Donation Form to each item you wish to donate so we know where the item is from and can contact you with any questions.

Q: How do you decide which items are sold at The Relief Sale?

A: The Quilt Committee meets once all donations have been received and reviews all items. We consider the quality of workmanship and materials, fabric and color choices, and how similar items have sold in the past.

Q: What happens to my item if it is not selected for the Auction?

A: It is up to the discretion of the Quilt Committee to determine where we believe your item will best support the work of MCC. Sometimes this means that your item may be moved to a different section of the Relief Sale, like Artisan's Market or the Silent Auction. If you would prefer the item be returned to you if it is not selected for the Quilt Auction, please indicate this on the donation form.
